- Anna Bon, *Sonata V in g minor*, Op.1; no repeats, ornamentation optional (ca. 1760)
- Contrasting work(s) or movement(s)

Youth Artist Elementary (through 6th grade)

8-minute program

- J. S. Bach, *Sonata in Eb Major*, BWV 1031, II. Siciliano (ca. 1730)
- Contrasting work(s) or movement(s)

Festival Divisions

Specialty: Adult Amateur, Piccolo
